All scientific articles submitted for publication are tested in the Antiplagiat. VUZ system and peer-reviewed. They will be entered in the RSCI database.

The level of originality of scientific papers:

- published in the collection not less than 60%;
- published in journals not less than 70%.

Requirements for a scientific article (for publication in the conference collection)

<u>A scientific article</u>, <u>information about the author</u> and <u>the Antiplagiat.VUZ system report</u> should be sent by mail: <u>konf-2021@mail.ru</u> (subject line: Surname_Scientific conference. If there are several authors, surnames are separated by commas).

The submitted materials must contain a problem statement, the solution of which will be contained in the article.

The length of an article is 4-10 A4 pages (font size – 16 pt., Times New Roman; line spacing – 1.0; all margins – 20 mm; full justification; paragraph indentation – 10 mm; automatic hyphenation of words). The style is normal.

The paragraph spacing is not used.

Tables should be designed in Microsoft Word (Tables should be formatted *in portrait orientation*, not on a landscape page. Do not insert tables as pictures!). You should use 12 pt., line spacing – 1.0. Each table must be referred to in the main body of the text.

You should use equation editor for equations.

Figures can only be presented in black and white (not color) using shading (figures is only in portrait orientation).

Figures in the text of the article should be presented in a grouped form. There should be links to figures in the article.

The dash and quotation marks must be the same style throughout the text.

References to literature in the text should be presented in square brackets (for example, [4] or [2, p. 15]). References are numbered manually (not automatically).

Pages should not be numbered.

Students submit articles only with a supervisor.

Articles in violation of these requirements will not be accepted for publication.

When you write an article, you must provide the following information:

• UDC – in capital letters, bold, left alignment, without indentation;

further in English:

- title of the article in capital letters, bold, center alignment, no hyphenation, no indentation, font size –
 16 pt., spacing 1.0;
- surname and first name of the author (in full), academic degree, academic title, position (if there are 2 or more authors, they should be presented as a separate line) - in lowercase letters, starting with a capital letter, center alignment, without hyphenation, font size – 14 pt., line spacing – 1.0;
- the full name of the university, city, country in lower case letters, starting with a capital letter, center alignment, in italics, without hyphenation, font size 14 pt., interval 1.0;
- abstract with paragraph indention, italics, font size 14 pt., interval 1.0;
- keywords in lowercase letters, starting with uppercase, left alignment (without indentation), in italics, without hyphenation, font size 14 pt., interval 1.0.

in Russian:

- title of the article in capital letters, bold, center alignment, without hyphenation, without indentation, font size 16 pt., line spacing 1.0;
- surname, first name, patronymic of the author (in full), academic degree, academic rank, position (if there are 2 or more authors, they should be presented as a separate line) in lower case letters, starting with

- capital letters, center alignment, without hyphenation, without paragraph indentation, font size –14 pt., line spacing 1.0;
- the full name of the university, city, country in lower case letters, starting with the capital one, center alignment, without hyphenation, without indentation, font size 14 pt., line spacing 1.0;
- abstract with paragraph indention (no more than 400 characters with spaces), italics, font size 14 pt., interval 1.0;
- keywords in lowercase letters, starting with capital, left alignment (no paragraph indent), without hyphenation, in italics, font size 14 pt., interval 1.0;
